Subject: Barbershops reopening with restrictions

Dear barbers, barbershops, and barber schools,

Today, Governor Cooper announced the beginning of Phase 2 of the economy reopening, effective Friday, May 22, at 5:00 PM. Barbershops and schools are included in Phase 2, but **you must meet certain requirements**. I've attached guidance from the Department of Health and Human Services that explains what things are required and what things are recommended.

Although the document is identified as guidance, please note that certain items – such as limitations on the number of people in the shop or school and the requirement for face coverings for workers – are **requirements**. By adhering to these requirements, you will help make sure that the governor doesn't pull back on Phase 2 or establish additional restrictions.
