Dear schools:

Many of you may know of two developments that the board is working on that will affect the administration of exams: (1) a switch to mannequin-based exams, which you recently received a letter about, and (2) an office move to a smaller location, which will allow us to free up funds to hire an additional inspector. Instead of having exams at the board office, we plan to hold exams at schools that are willing to host us.

The purpose of this letter is to see whether your school would like to host the board. Below is some information about the exams.

- We tend to hold exams on Mondays and Tuesdays, but we are flexible about dates to accommodate your schedule.
- The exams would include both written and practical exams.
- We would be happy to be hosted by schools that have fewer barber chairs or smaller classroom space, though schools with more chairs would be able to accommodate more applicants.
- You can host the exams as often or as infrequently as you wish.
- Since we're moving in October, we would begin testing at schools in November.
